

Ready for Photos?

The driveway and front yard of the home should be clear of any vehicles or objects to provide the best possible images.
Remove any large objects from the back yard that can be moved easily, like landscape equipment, trash cans, and toys.
All lights in the home should be turned on, as well as turning off all fans and TV screens in the rooms.
Open all curtains and blinds to provide the best possible lighting in the home.
Remove all evidence of pets from the home, including water bowls and beds.
All countertops should be free of personal belongings and other clutter. Trash cans, paper towels, dish rags and soap dispensers can be hidden away in closets or pantries. We do not photograph Closets, garages or pantries so theyre great places to hide things!
Clean homes always photograph better. If the home can be professionally cleaned prior to photography, we highly recommend it.
